### Square in a Square Star

Here is block number ten of our block of the month quilt. This is an easy block this month. It is a square within a square block, which makes a very nice star. The block has three fabrics, the background, the star points and center, and the third fabric is the square within the square.

Each letter on the diagram represents a fabric. Use the diagrams on the right side to guide you when cutting out the pieces. If you have questions please call me at 408-264-7121. ### Cutting:

#### Background fabric (A)

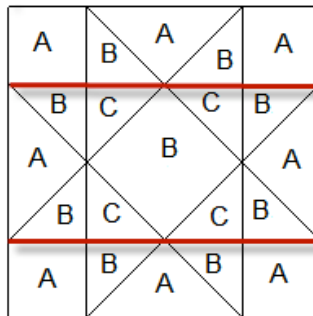
1. Cut four  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
2. Cut two  $7\frac{3}{16}$ " by  $7\frac{3}{16}$ " squares and cut diagonally twice. You will have 4 triangles.

#### Second fabric (B)

1. Cut four  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " by  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and cut diagonally twice. You will have 8 triangles.
2. Cut one  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " by  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " square.

#### Third fabric (C)

1. Cut two  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " by  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and cut diagonally once. You will have 4 triangles.



### **Assemble:**

1. Assemble as shown.
