BROWN BAG ORPHAN BLOCK
CHALLENGE RULES**

You must use some of the enclosed orphan blocks in your quilt.

You may add fabric to the orphan blocks.

Any manipulation of the blocks is allowed; i.e.: cut, dye, paint, stamp, etc.

Please, no beading, buttons or other types of loose embellishments. Quilts may be given to babies or small children.

Quilts must be machine washable.

Size considerations are a minimum of 36 inches by 36 inches to a maximum of 60 inches by 80 inches.

Deadline is Tuesday, August 23, 2010. At the August SCVQA meeting a parade of finished "orphan block" quilts will happen. All participants parading their quilts will have their names placed in a drawing at this meeting. Five names will be drawn for prizes from our affiliate shops.

Please attach the label below to your finished quilt.
