



Scrappy strips

Cut newspaper or muslin into 10-1/2 squares. This quilt can be all scrappy or some theme (blue/yellow, red/white/blue, etc.). Cut your larger pieces into 11-1/2 or 12 inch squares, then cut diagonally. These are the solid triangles. The rest of the fabric is cut into strips ranging from 1-1/2 inches to 4 the length of the fabric. To piece - start with one triangle right side up. Pin or use a glue stick to hold it in place on the paper. Add a strip, right sides together and sew along the diagonal. You can fold the paper to mark the diagonal, draw a line from corner to corner, whatever works for you. Fold back the strip and press. Continue adding strips till the paper is covered. Flip it over and trim to the size of the paper/muslin. If using paper, now you have to rip it off. Muslin stays on but makes a heavier quilt.
