Block Party for June

The sun is out. Life is good. Let's rock this month with Jungle Boogie

Materials Needed

Sashing: Orange or dark gold: 2 1/2" by 23 1/2". Cut into three lengths; 4 1/2", 6 1/2" and 12 1/2".

Four blocks: Go with wild and colorful fabrics. There are two squares and two rectangles. You can make them all different, or you might make the two squares (opposite corners) from one fabric, and the two rectangles (opposite corners) from a second fabric.

Sizes: One 6 1/2" square, One 4 1/2" square and two rectangles 4 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Instructions

Cut the pieces as indicated above. Lay them out in position and piece as indicated in the sample. Your block will be 12 1/2".

To participate, make the block described, bring it to the next meeting, post your block(s) on the design board, and place your name (one for each block you bring) into the pot. A winning name from those who contributed will be drawn; the winner takes home all the blocks.
