

## Block Party for November

This month's block, Double X, requires some analogous colors. Now don't fret, this is really easy. See the color wheel illustration which demonstrates that yellow, yellow orange, and orange are analogous. We'd like you to use two colors that are close on the wheel. So it could also be green/blue, purple/red, green/yellow, etc.

### Materials needed

Color Print 1: Four  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.  
Analogous Color Print 2: Four  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.  
White on White: Four  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

### Directions

Start by sewing two sets of half square triangles. Put right sides together of two of the  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " color print 1 squares with two of the white on white squares. In each set draw a diagonal line on one side. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the line and cut on the line. You will now have four half square triangle blocks. Press seams to the dark fabric. Now repeat with two of the color print 2 with two white on white. And repeat again with the remaining two color print 1 and color print 2. You now have four each of three different blocks. You will use only three of each. Now lay them out carefully to duplicate the sample block and sew together in three rows. Your block will be  $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

To participate, make the block described, bring it to the next meeting, post your block(s) on the design board, and place your name (one for each block you bring) into the pot. A winning name from those who contributed will be drawn; the winner takes home all the blocks.
