

Block Party for January

The Disappearing 9 Patch Block is a colorful, fun way to start the new year. For the three fabrics listed you may use plain or “reads as plain”.

Materials needed

Black: Four 4” squares

White: Four 4” squares

Bright Color: One 4” square

Directions

Sew together the nine 4” squares as illustrated with the bright color in the center and the blacks in the four corners. Your block should now measure 11” square. Cut in half in each direction (5 1/2”). Pivot two opposite corners so that the bright colors are now in outside corners instead of in the center. Sew together. Your finished block should now be 10 1/2”.

To participate, make the block described, bring it to the next meeting, post your block(s) on the design board, and place your name (one for each block you bring) into the pot. A winning name from those who contributed will be drawn; the winner takes home all the blocks.
