BLOCK PARTY – OCTOBER 2022 HALLOWEEN

Fussy cut a favorite Halloween fabric for the onpoint center square for this block. Then add black and a second Halloween color (orange, purple, green) that coordinates with your center square. This traditional block is called "Right & Left."

Cutting: Lightly spray squares with starch or starch alternative to stabilize edges.

- A. Halloween fabric cut one 4.75-inch square on-point, so the up/down orientation of the pattern is on the diagonal.
- B. Black cut one 4.5-inch square, then cut diagonally in both directions to make four quarter-square triangles.
- C. Second color cut one 4.5-inch square, then cut diagonally in both directions to make four quarter-square triangles.



- 1. Arrange a black and colored triangle on each side of the center square as shown in the picture
- 2. Sew each black and colored triangle unit together; press towards the black
- 3. Sew one of these triangle units to each side of the center square, matching the centers; press.
- 4. Trim to a 6.5-inch square, maintaining the quarter-inch seam allowance beyond the center square corners.

Block will measure 6.5-inches square

Your name will be entered once for each block received (enclose a note if you don't want your name in the drawing). Blocks must be received by Saturday, October 22nd.
