## Coins and Stripes Kit

Each kit makes a 53" x 70.5" quilt top and contains:

## 126 coins ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles)

42 block stripes ( $2.5 \times 16$ " strips)
10 strips for sashing and border strips (2.5" x 42" strips or about 420" total length)

- You will need 21 completed blocks (Figure 1) for this quilt.
- Prepare blocks by sewing 6 coins together, then add 2 stripes to the long side (Figure 1). Note that stripes might be longer than needed. Hint: alternate direction you sew the seams when joining coins and stipes to keep the stacks straight.
- Blocks should measure $15.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ ". Trim if necessary.
- Arrange the blocks in as shown (Figure 2). Sew each column of 7 blocks together. Measure the column lengths (should be about 67"). Trim if necessary to get column lengths equal.

- Prepare sashing strips by sewing sashing strips together, then cut to the column length measured above.
Note: be sure to remove any selvedges before joining sashing strips!
- Use sashing strips to join the 3 columns as shown. Press seams toward sashing strips. Trim top and bottom edges as necessary to even quilt edges.
- Prepare border strips for long sides by sewing strips together and cutting to measured column lengths. Note: be sure to remove any selvedges before joining border strips!
- Attach side borders and press seams towards border. Trim any excess fabric to even quilt edges.
- Prepare border strips for short sides (top and bottom) by sewing strips together and cutting to measured width. This should be about 53 ".
- Add top and bottom borders and trim excess fabric
