

Stacked Coins Kit

Each kit makes a 32.5" x 42.5" quilt top and contains:

60 coins (3" x 6" rectangles)

7 Strips for sashing and border (2.5" x 42" or about 300" total)

- Divide the coins into 4 piles of 15 coins each. Arrange each stack of coins and sew each stack together into a column. Press seams in one direction.
Hint: alternate direction you sew the seams between coins to keep the stacks straight.
- Measure the 4 stacks of coins. If necessary, trim to be sure stacks are the same length.
- Prepare sashing strips to the measured length of your stacks. If necessary, trim selvages from sashing strips but be careful to remove as little fabric as possible.
- Use the sashing strips to join the 4 coin stacks and for borders on the long sides as shown. Press seams toward sashing and border strips. If necessary, trim to even the top and bottom edges.
- Add top and bottom sashing strips and trim excess fabric to complete quilt top.
