



Supply List

Fabric Estimates

- Two background fabrics for quilt front: 5/8 yard each, these will be woven together,
- Muslin, or other neutral fabric, to provide foundation for quilt front background: 5/8 yard
- Backing fabric: 5/8 yard
- Binding for quilt: 1/4 yard of one fabric, or scraps for a multi fabric binding
- Fabric for quilt sleeve: 8-1/2" x 16"
- Fabric scraps: 6" wide x 24" long per each large flower
- Fabric scraps: 5" wide x 15" long per each small flower
- Fabric scraps: for leaves
- Fabric scraps: for fabric covered buttons

Other Supplies

- Batting: 5/8 yard
- Ultra firm stabilizer scraps: (ex: *Peltex*) for base of flowers. You can substitute heavy felt, or heavy cardstock.
- Fusible adhesive: 2-3/4 yards (ex: *HeatnBond Lite*)
- Fabric covered buttons: five 1-1/2", two 1-1/8", and eight 7/8" (ex: *Dritz, Craft Cover Button Kits*). Store bought buttons may also be used.
- Fabric glue (ex: *Tacky Glue*)
- Threads (ex: *Sulky* for decorative top stitching)
- Sewing needle size 12 or 14
- Press cloth
- Sewing machine, pins, fabric scissors, paper scissors, rotary cutter, mat, long ruler, pencil, eraser, marking pen, and masking tape

Notes

This art was created using a zigzag stitch. Feel free to substitute any of your favorite decorative stitches.

Also, feel free to personalize your *Posies In The Sunshine* as you choose. Consider my instructions as guidelines that you can adapt to your liking.
